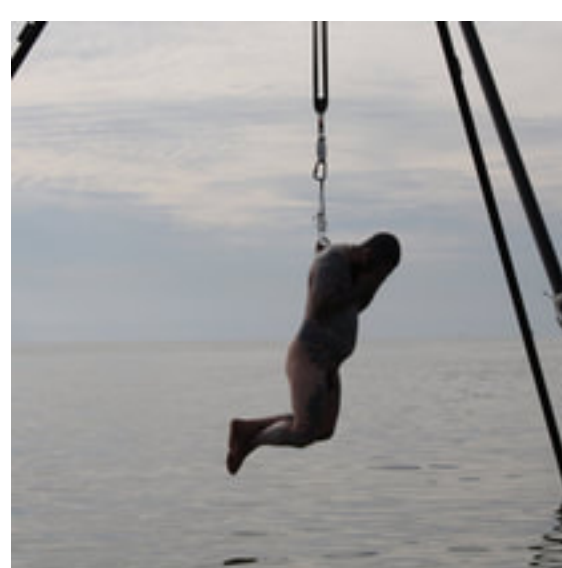
# Shared Sacred

## Landscapes of Religious Plurality

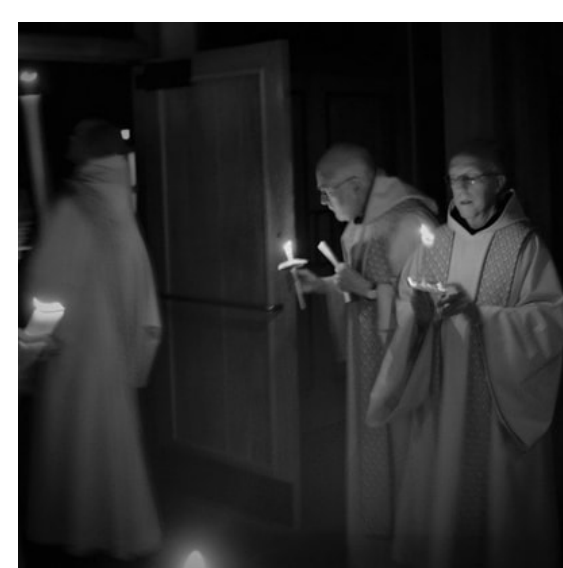
